

MONSTERA DELICIOSA Rhaphidophora Tetrasperma

Commonly known as the Swiss Cheese plant, the Monstera Deliciosa is a low-maintenance climbing evergreen with lush, unique foliage.

GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN:

Thailand and Malaysia

GREAT FOR: Moderate Sunlight

FEATURES: Unique Foliage

GROWTH RATE: Fast



LIGHT

Prefers bright, indirect light but can tolerate low light as well. Avoid direct sunlight. Growth will be slower in low light environments.



DIFFICULTY

Easy! Just make sure the plant isn't in direct sunlight and don't overwater.



FERTILIZER

Feed with a mild liquid, indoor plant fertilizer about 1-2 times a month during the growing season.



PRUNING & PROPAGATION

Prune yellow or damaged stems down to soil level. To propagate, cut just below a node on the stem and place in water.







WATER

About once a week. Allow soil to mostly dry out – but not completely. Water less often in winter. If leaves develop brown tips, air may be too dry.



TEMPERATURE

Prefers warm conditions above 60°F. Keep away from drafty windows and air conditioners.



SOIL

A peaty All-Purpose potting soil with good drainage works best.
