GREAT FOR: Bright indirect light

FEATURES:

GROWTH RATE: Slow



LIGHT

Gymnocalyciums prefer bright indirect light. Placing them near a window with filtered or indirect sunlight is usually ideal.



WATER

Allow soil to mostly dry out between waterings.



DIFFICULTY

Easy! Just place in bright indirect sunlight and don't overwater.



FERTILIZER

It's recommended to fertilize Gymnocalyciums about once every two to three months during spring and summer.



TEMPERATURE

The ideal temperature range for Gymnocalyciums is between 65°F and 80°F. They are comfortable in typical room temperatures.



SOIL

Use a well-draining cactus or succulents potting mix.



PRUNING & PROPAGATION

Trim off any dead or decaying parts of the plant to maintain its health and appearance.
