

NEON POTHOS Epipremnum aureum

The perfect houseplant for beginners, Neon Pothos is wonderfully low-maintenance and great for purifying the air.

GEOGRAPHIC ORIGIN:

Southeast Asia

GREAT FOR: Low Sunlight

FEATURES:

Low Maintenance, Air Purifying

GROWTH RATE: Slow in low light



LIGHT

Grows more quickly in bright, indirect light but can tolerate low light as well. Avoid direct sunlight.



DIFFICULTY

Easy! Just avoid direct sunlight and cold temperatures.



FERTILIZER

Feed with a mild liquid, indoor plant fertilizer about 1-2 times a month during the growing season.



PRUNING & PROPAGATION

Prune damaged or yellow leaves by cutting to the leaf node. To propagate, place stems of vine cuttings in water and roots should form within a week or so. Replant in soil.







WATER

Allow top few inches of soil to dry out before watering thoroughly. Water less often in winter.



TEMPERATURE

Prefers warm conditions above 60°F. Keep away from drafty windows and air conditioners.



SOII

A peaty All-Purpose potting soil with good drainage works best.



PET FRIENDLY?

Sorry! Plant contains very sharp calcium oxalate crystals that, when eaten, cause mouth and digestion irritation.
